



The Infant/Toddler Program

Certification Level:

International Montessori Council¹ (IMC) Certification for teaching ages 0-3 years (Full Certification is MACTE² accredited).

Length of Course: 18 months

Components:

- ◆ Distance learning coursework over the entire 18 months with one week break approximately every 9 weeks and 2 week winter and summer breaks.
- ◆ Single Residential Session – 120 hour session takes place over 2½ weeks, usually during the first summer.
- ◆ Practicum requirement – 9 months, 400 hour practicum internship in an approved Montessori Infant or Toddler classroom or a Montessori Parent/Infant program.

*The Associate Certificate is awarded to students who complete the distance learning and practicum phase only. The Full Certificate will be awarded to students who complete the distance learning, practicum phase and residential session. While these hybrid programs may not be available to students living in the most remote places, we believe Full Certificate programs will provide the best quality of education. Student teaching at both tiers work very much like in a traditional Montessori teacher certificate training program, in that the program will help students select internship schools and will perform the training evaluation.

Admission Requirements:

- ◆ A high proficiency in English is require for successful participation in this program. CGMS reserves the right to require, at its discretion, for applicants to provide evidence of their English proficiency by submitting TOEFL scores.
- ◆ Bachelor's degree in any discipline, but exceptions can be made with the Director's approval.
